Qualifier for Blair Castle Horse Trials 24<sup>th</sup> August 2009.
- Class 2. Nursery (70cm) See rules attached for eligibility
- Class 3. Novice (85cm) See rules attached for eligibility
- Class 4. Intermediate (95cm)
- Class 5. Open (1.05m)

# RULES

## Show Jumping

Nursery - this is a true nursery competition. Horses not to have won any money in any competition with jumping, been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at Novice level or above, or competed in any British Eventing at PN or higher level (max 70 cm).

Novice - horses not to have won more than £20 in any competition with jumping at Novice Level or above or have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at R.C. Intermediate level or above or have competed at British Eventing Novice level or higher (max 85cm)

Minimum age for horses, 4 years in classes 1 and 2 & 5 years in class 3 or 4. Horses entered in Class 2 are not eligible for class 3 & 4. Horses may run in 2 classes. HC entries will be accepted but horses cannot ride in any other class. Riders must be 16 years and over. Scoring will be as BRC. Style Jumping rules are as per BRC Year book and the jumping track should be ridden in a simple snaffle, as per the BD Rulebook. Nosebands should be cavasson, flash, grackle or drop.

The Show Jumping competition is part of the EFRA Summer League and points are awarded 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> in each class. The combination of horse and rider will accrue points in their class and rosettes and trophies will be presented at the final competition.

## Working Hunter

The Finals will be held at Blair Castle Horse Trials on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2009. This series is for horses 153cm & over, 4 years old and over. Riders to be 17 years or over on the day of competition. The classes will be judged in line with the Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain Rules (can download - [www.sporhorsegb.co.uk](http://www.sporhorsegb.co.uk)).

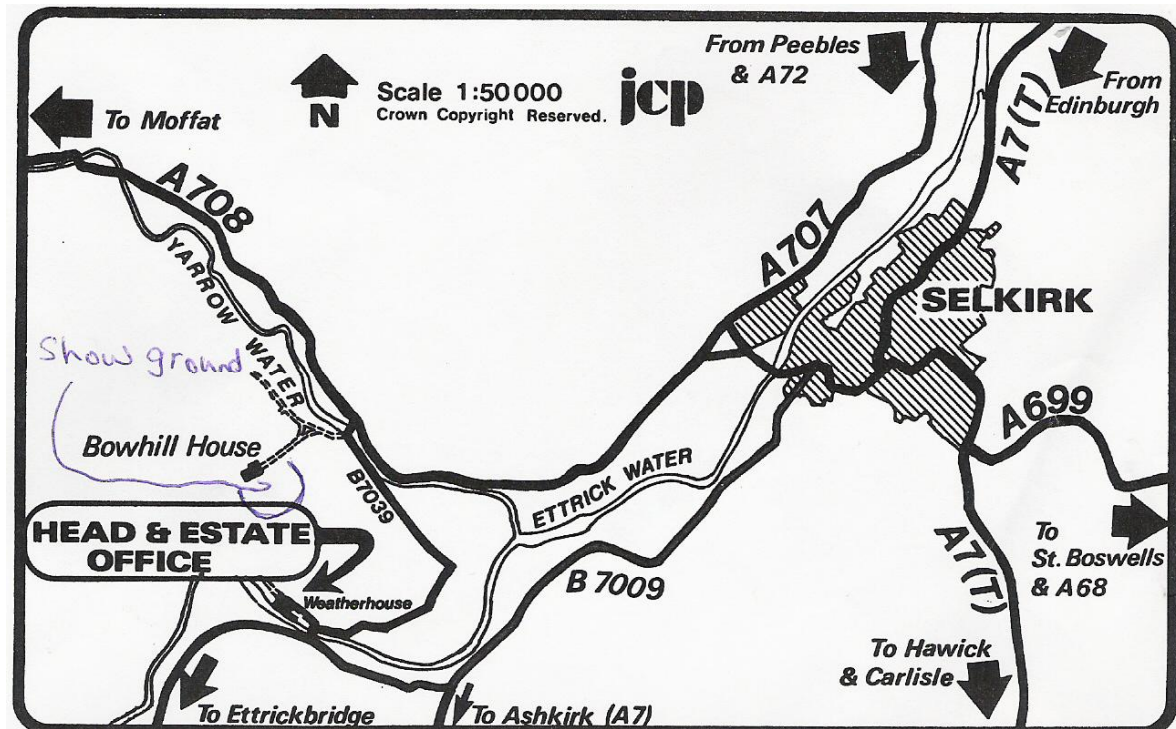
### **Riding Hats to be in accordance with current BRC Rule Book.**

The first 3 prize winners will qualify for the final. To be eligible for the Qualifying Rounds and the Final, the rider of the horse must be a member of a British Riding Club affiliated to BRC. To be eligible to compete in the qualifying rounds horses must not have won £150 or more in BSJA classes and must not have more than 3 BE points.

At the competition the first 3 riders will be handed a postcard to complete and return with their entry fee for the Final. In the event of one of the qualifiers having already qualified, the postcard will be handed down the line as far as the fourth prize winner PROVIDED THEY HAD A CLEAR ROUND IN THE JUMPING PHASE.

## All Classes

Special rosettes will be awarded to retrained Thoroughbreds. A Weatherby passport will be required as proof.
